Israeli Troops Kill Two More Palestinians in Occupied West Bank



United Nations, March 2 (RHC)-- Israeli forces have shot and killed two more Palestinians over an alleged stabbing attack north of the occupied West Bank. Local media reported that the two were killed early Wednesday after they allegedly wounded an Israeli settler in the settlement of Eli, located south of the city of Nablus.

The incident came a day after Israeli forces raided the Palestinian refugee camp of Qalandiya in the occupied West Bank, killing a Palestinian youth and injuring a dozen others.

More than 190 Palestinians, including children and women, have lost their lives at the hands of Israeli forces since the beginning of last October.
