Havana and Portugal Consolidate Cultural Exchange



Havana, Apr 5 (RHC) Havana and Lisbon have initiated several ministerial meetings in order to consolidate cultural interchange.

Américo Castro, president of Cuba-Portugal's Chamber of Commerce said to RHC that in 2016 they will spend several days deepening the cultural expressions of both countries.

"Right now we are putting together a plan where we want to bring to Cuba several groups representing various areas of culture. "Last year we had two concerts of José María Vitier in Portugal, one in Oporto and another in Lisbon. It was a formidable thing, theaters were completely filled and everybody was asking for another

presentation like that. I think we have many ideas to make fantastic things. I would say as Raul Castro says "slowly but not stopping".
