Havana, April 15(RHC)-- A delegation from the U.S. President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities (PCAH) will visit Cuba from April 18th through the 21st to exchange with representatives from Cuba's main cultural institutions and companies, according to the Cuban Culture Ministry.

A news release published in this morning's edition of Granma newspaper explains that the President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities is an advisory committee to the White House on cultural issues.
