

North Korean Leader Praises Friendship and Cooperation Ties with Cuba



Pyongyang, July 1 (RHC)-- North Korean leader Kim Jong-un said his government is determined to further advance his country's friendship and cooperation ties with Cuba.

Kim Jong-un, who is also the Chairman of the Workers' Party of Korea, met Thursday in Pyongyang with visiting Cuban Vice President Salvador Valdés Mesa.
