

Puerto Rican Solidarity with Cuba Brigade Arrives in Havana



Havana, July 12 (RHC)--The 2016 contingent of the Puerto Rican Juan Rius Rivera Solidarity with Cuba Brigade arrived in Havana on Monday. Over a hundred activists make up the group this year. This is the brigade's 25th visit to Cuba.
